Both Indiana travel meets went very well. We had more State cuts made, some very good finishes and near Junior National qualifying times. Results from both meets were very encouraging for the rest of our summer season. The team will be traveling to Indiana again next year so I encourage more families to plan for the same weekend and join us!

### **Looking Ahead:**

We have a couple meets in the month of June including our last home meet of the summer. Once again we have set a new record for swimmers attending the meet with 76!!! As a coach this means a lot to me because it shows how competitive we are becoming and also shows us the progress your swimmer is making. The other meet in June is a long course meet hosted by Shorewood at the Walter Schroeder Aquatic Center, in Brown Deer. This meet is geared more for our seniors and upper level age group swimmers because it is in a 50M pool. If you are swimming the second session and want to swim in another meet I suggest the Silver State meet which is open to all Non-state meet qualifiers. It is a great season ending meet for all of our swimmers.
