Howdy!

The cold weather is right around the corner so please bring warm clothes to wear home after practice. Some new families may be wondering, "How is my swimmer doing?" This is a very good question. There are many ways to answer this question. The obvious way is to look at their time improvements from meet to meet. If you enter your child in a meet their results will be posted on our bulletin board and website. You can tell how they are doing by comparing their previous swims to their most recent ones. Another way is by looking at test set results. I have been posting results on the bulletin board on different sets we do each week including the kicking wall of fame. Take some time to look or ask your swimmers coach after practice about their progress. Lastly, you can always set up a quick meeting with your swimmers coach for before or after practice. The easiest way to improve is by listening to your coach, asking appropriate questions, attending as many practices as possible and of course trying hard!
