- Location:** Walter Schroeder Aquatic Center
9240 N. Green Bay Rd.
Brown Deer, WI
- Facility:** The Schroeder Aquatic Center is an eight lane, 50-meter pool with non-turbulent lane markers and backstroke flags. Pool depth at starting end is 7' – turn end is 16'. Block height is 29.5". Backstroke wedges are available. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.
- Timing:** SST timing system with aqua grip touch pads, backup buttons with backup watches.
- Class of Meet:** Summer Regional Time Standard, WI LSC dictated.
- Eligibility:** All swimmers must be currently registered with Wisconsin Swimming. USA Swimming deck registrations will not be accepted. Age as of July 15th 2022.
- Qualification:** There are no qualifying times for this meet. Swimmers may enter and compete in any event in which they do not have the WI State qualifying time. The time standards are listed at <http://www.wisconsinswimming.org>. If a swimmer makes the qualifying time in an event after Wednesday, July 6, 2022, they will be allowed to compete in that event at the Summer Regional Championships.
- If a swimmer, age 14 or under, has achieved the WI State cut in a given race, they can enter the Senior age group for that event, if and only if, they have NOT achieved the WI State cut in the Senior (15&Over) age group. Any swimmer that has already achieved the Senior (15&Over) cut is not allowed to swim that race.
- Non-conforming Times:** DO NOT CONVERT. All courses will be used. Non-conforming times will be seeded after the LCM times. The order used for seeding will be LCM, SCY, SCM.
- Rules:** Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), will govern this meet. A registered athlete member at a sanctioned/approved meet who is 18 years of age or older, who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (APT) by the date of the swim, will not be able to upload into SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered “not in good standing” and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.
- USA Swimming membership is required for deck access. Coaches and officials should display their USA Swimming card when on the pool deck or be able to produce credential upon request. Non-athlete members are only allowed on deck for official business. Deck Pass is an acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. Further, those participants not proficient with a backstroke ledge must start each race from within the water, and without use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Saturday and Sunday PM Warm-up, Meet Start TBD
PM session will start no later than 75 min after the AM session ends

All warm up sessions, meet start times, and breaks will be determined after entries are received. Saturday and Sunday warm ups will be assigned at the discretion of the meet host. Estimated meet timeline will be available on the homepage of the Rocket Aquatics Swim Club as soon as it is available.

Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect. Swimmers must enter the pool from the starting end using a three point entry for warm-up. Violators of the Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures are subject to disqualifications. There will warm-up lanes available in the adjacent YMCA pool throughout the meet.

Time Trials will begin promptly. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to be at the blocks, complete with her/his two timers (and two watches), ready to swim.

Entry Deadline:

Team entries as Hy-Tek entry file, soft copy (as pdf), waiver (as pdf), and fees must be received by the Entry Chair no later than **Wednesday, July 6, 2022**. You will receive a confirmation e-mail of receipt of entries.

Update of times/events can be made up to Monday, July 11.

Entry Limit: Participation is limited to seven (7) individual events for the meet excluding time trials.

The maximum number of individual events in one day is six (6) and includes Time Trials (USA 102.2.3 and 102.2.7). This means that a swimmer may swim 6 individual events total, including a combination of:

- 1) only Time Trials
- 2) combined Time Trials and meet events
- 3) only meet events

Entry Fees: \$7.00 per individual events, \$14.00 per relay entry, \$16.00 WSAC Surcharge, and \$4.00 WI LSC Splash Fee for each swimmer entered in the meet. Form of payment is due by the start of the competition. Checks should be made payable to "Rocket Aquatics Swim Club".

NOTE: Please be sure that the waiver is signed and provided to host club prior to the entries deadline. Entries without a waiver won't be accepted.

Deck Entries: Deck entries are at discretion of the meet host.

Waiver: Adult athletes or Parent/Guardian of a minor must complete the competition waiver online.

Format: This is a timed final meet. All events will be pre-seeded except for the 400 IM, 400 Free, 800 Free, and 1500 Free events.

Deck seeded events: The 400 IM, the 400 Free, the 800 Free, and the 1500 free events will be positive check-in events and deck seeded. Positive check in for these events will close 30 minutes before the start of the session in which the event is swum. These events will be swum fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys.

The Wisconsin Scratch rule will be in effect for this meet. Failure to scratch prior to seeding or failure to declare a false start with the Deck Referee prior to the start of the swimmer's heat and not swimming the event will result in the swimmer being barred from the next individual event in which he/she is entered. Swimmers who do not check in will not be seeded in the event.

Coaches Packet: Coaches shall sign-in to the meet at the beginning of each session as they pick up team packets at the pool office. Any fees owed must be paid before you can obtain your packet. Please be prepared to show your proof of valid USA Swimming Coach Certification at the time you pick up your team packet.

Awards: Individual awards: 1st – 16th ribbons
High point awards: 1st – 3rd (male & female) for 10&U, 11-12, 13-14 age groups.
No high point awards for Senior age group.

Awards will be bagged by team for coach pick up at the end of meet. Unclaimed awards will be taken to the 12 & Under WI LCM State Championships or the 13 & Over WI LCM State Championships. Awards will not be mailed after the conclusion of the meet.

- Heat Sheets:** Heat sheets will be available electronically for free, link will be shared with attending teams prior to the meet. Heat sheets of deck-seeded events will be posted around the pool as well as in the hallway after positive check-in is closed. Heat sheets will be available on the meet landing page.
- Admissions:** For all spectators over 12 years of age: \$6.00 per session. Handicap seating will be available; please contact the meet director in advance so accommodations may be made.
- Live streaming will be available – details will be posted at the meet home page.
- Concessions:** Concessions will be available. No food will be allowed in the pool area.
- Parking:** Parking lots map is [available here](#). Free parking is available on the west side of the building and in the parking lots behind Office Depot in the Marketplace of Brown Deer Shopping Center. Parking is available on the east side of the building for a \$5 charge per entry. Do not park in other areas of the shopping center, including behind the Pick-n Save building.
- Conduct:** Please follow the athlete and parent conduct guidelines below. Anyone not following these rules may be subject to removal from the meet and facility. Each team is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers and parents.
- Teams are asked to pick up any garbage in their immediate team area after each session.
- Only counters and officials are allowed on the bulkheads or pool edge during competition.
- No coolers, chairs, or large bags will be allowed in the main pool spectator area.
- Swimmers (and their bags) should sit in their team's area on the pool deck.
- No standing on the stairways or landing areas of the spectator area. No chairs or sleeping bags are allowed in the hallways.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.
- Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.

Flash photography and photography from behind the starting blocks are prohibited at the start of each race. Only designated photographers will be allowed on deck during the warmups and meet.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Vice President of Program Operations.

Coaching Credentials

Meet Directors/Meet Marshalls or their designee will check coach's credentials that are on the deck for all sanctioned meets. Coaches not in good standing WILL NOT be allowed on the pool deck. They are allowed to be in the spectator stands but NOT on the pool deck. Coach must sign in and show their deck pass.

First Aid:

Report injuries to the Lifeguard and Meet Director. First aid kit is located at the lifeguard station in front of the pool office.

- Time Trials:** Time Trials will be offered Saturday and Sunday at the conclusion of the PM Sessions and/or as time permits and at the discretion of the Meet Director.
- Events:** See meet order of events listing.
- Fees:** \$15.00/event.
- Registration:** Entries will be accepted during all sessions up to 60 minutes before the end of the PM session. Swimmers do not need to be entered in the Summer Regional Meet in order to participate in Time Trials. If a swimmer is not signed up for the Silver Meet they must be able to prove they are registered with USA Swimming for 2022. Swimmers must be registered as Wisconsin Swimming Athletes to participate in time trials.
- Procedure:**
- Swimmer will sign up for an event at the meet management table.
 - If not a participant of the Summer Regional meet, the swimmer will prove 2022 USA registration.
 - Swimmer will fill out a seed card at the table - swimmer's name, age, team, event name and seed time.
 - Seed card and event fee must be turned into the table before the registration deadline.
 - An announcement will be made indicating the time that Time Trials will begin.
 - A meeting for all time trial participants and timers will be held prior to the start of Time Trials.
 - Cards with heat and lane assignments will be handed out at this meeting.
 - It is the swimmer's responsibility to be ready to swim when his/her event, name, and lane number are called. The Referee will not hold the start of the event waiting for a swimmer or timer to show.
 - ALL time trial cards (whether or not a swimmer swims a desired time) **MUST** be turned in at the end of each heat.
- Meet Host Provides:** Officials, Timing System Operator, and Meet Management, watches
- Swimmer Provides:** Two (2) timers, and a person to count laps (if needed).
