Concessions will be available. <b>No food or beverage is allowed on the pool deck or in spectator areas.</b>  <i>The competition course has not been certified in accordance with USA Swimming's Rule 104.2.2C(4).</i>

Timing	<p>All events will be timed using Colorado System 6 timing system with horn start, touch pads, button, and two watches as backup.</p> <p><b><u>For 25y events:</u></b> Swimmers will start at the blocks and finish at the bulkhead (timing by button with two watches as backup). The Meet Director reserves the right to reverse the starting and finishing ends pending any timing equipment issues. Any changes will be immediately communicated to participants and coaches.</p>
Rules	<p>Official 2022 USA Swimming Rules and Wisconsin Swimming Rules shall govern the conduct of this meet. All athletes must be registered USA Swimming members. Age is as of November 18, 2022.</p> <p>Out of state entrants must bring a valid USA Swimming card and present it to the Meet Director prior to swimming.</p> <p>All coaches, acting in a coaching capacity, must display the current membership card at all times while on deck.</p> <p>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</p> <p>All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. A registered athlete member at a sanctioned/approved meet who is 18 years of age or older, who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (APT) by the date of the swim, will not be able to upload into SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.</p>

Deck Entries	<p>Deck entries will be at the Meet Director's discretion, will only be allowed up until 30 minutes prior to the start of the session AND only if there are open lanes available (new heats will not be added). Deck entries must be able to prove their USA Swimming membership.</p> <p>Deck entry is \$10 per individual event (plus entry fees if athlete is not already registered in the meet) and \$20 per relay event (plus entry fees if athletes are not already registered in the meet).</p>
Special Needs	<p>Please contact the Meet Referee regarding any special needs/athletes requiring accommodation prior to the start of the meet.</p>
Entry Limits	<p>Athletes are limited to two (2) entries per day on Friday and four (4) individual events and one (1) relay event per day on both Saturday and Sunday, with a maximum of ten (10) individual events and two (2) relay events for the meet.</p> <p>Entries will be accepted in the order they are received.</p>

Events	<p>All events are pre-seeded. Fly over starts will be used.</p> <p>For 25y events, swimmers will start at the blocks and finish at the bulkhead (timing by button with stopwatch backup). The Meet Director reserves the right to reverse the starting and finishing ends pending any timing equipment issues. Any changes will be immediately communicated to participants and coaches.</p> <p>Friday distance events are Mixed/Open events, will be seeded fastest to slowest, and scored by age group (9-10, 11-12, Senior). <b>Athletes will need to provide their own timer and counter for Friday events</b> (lap counting boards furnished by MSS).</p> <p>For Saturday's 500 freestyle event, <b>athletes will need to provide their own counter</b> (timers and lap counting boards provided by MSS).</p>
100 Relay Events	For the 2nd and 4th legs of all 100 yard relay events, swimmers will begin from the bulkhead.
Admission	<p>\$5.00 admission for all spectators 13 and over.</p> <p>Seating available in the mezzanine for seniors and those needing special accommodation. Elevator available. Please see COVID Plan section of Meet Announcement</p>

Awards	<p>Individual events - 1st thru 16th place ribbons  Relay events - 1st thru 3rd place ribbons  Heat Winners provided for all events  Bag tag given to all registered athletes  No ribbons awarded for Open events  <b>Awards not claimed will be bagged and given to each clubs' coaches at the end of the meet.</b></p>

First Aid	Report injuries to the Lifeguard and Meet Director. First aid kit is located at the entrance of the pool office, behind the Timers Table
Conduct	<p>It is the swimmer's responsibility to be at the blocks at the start of their event. 8&amp;Under individual events will be staged by Clerk of Course, and assistance from coaches is appreciated.</p> <p>Swimmers and swimmers bags are not allowed in the mezzanine/spectator seating.</p> <p>No flash photography during the starts.</p>

Each team is responsible for the behavior of their swimmers. The Meet Director or the Meet Marshal may remove any swimmer from competition for disruptive or disorderly behavior.

In accordance with the Federal Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 - the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is strictly prohibited.

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.
