FACILITY: 25 yard pool with 8 lanes, non-turbulence lane markers and backstroke flags. Pool depth: 4'0" at non-starting end and 12' at starting end. 30" slanted starting blocks into 12' pool depth and Colorado automatic timing system. Please be advised that due to the depth of the non-starting end of the pool, the 2nd and 4th leg of all 100-Yard relays will start in the water. The Competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(c)(4). Copy of certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

TIMELINE: AM Session 1: Warm-ups 7:30a.m. Meet Starts: 8:30 a.m.
Session 2: Warm-ups begin at the end of the previous session.
The meet will begin one hour after warm-ups begin.
Feet First Three point entry form from the starting end of the pool during general warm-ups will be enforced for all sanctioned/approved competition.

TIMING: Events will be timed and judged by Colorado automatic timing system and judging equipment. Colorado horn starting system. Two back-up timers per lane will be provided.

ENTRIES: **EACH SWIMMER WILL BE LIMITED TO FOUR (4) INDIVIDUAL EVENTS AND ONE (1) RELAY.** Swimmer's age as of October 2nd, 2021 will determine his/her age group. **Deck entries will be accepted if open lanes are available and number of entries permit.** Parents should come to the pool office to complete the forms.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Completed individual and relay entry forms, waiver and fees must be received no later than **September 24th, 2021**. All entries should be submitted either on the enclosed entry form or on a Hy-tek Team Manager file. Submit all seed times in yard cutoff times. Be sure to indicate any UNATTACHED swimmers. **Hytek entries will be accepted and are preferred.** Please include a hard copy with all file entries.

All non-Wisconsin Swimming registered group members (teams) and athletes (including UN athletes outside of the WI LSC) wishing to participate within Wisconsin's LSC must obtain written approval from their respective LSC and forward it to meets@wisconsinswimming.org before participating within Wisconsin's LSC.

Meet hosts should not allow entries unless the requisite approval from the club/athletes home LSC is on file with the Wisconsin Swimming office. Times achieved by non-Wisconsin athletes where the home LSC did not approve of the athletes travel to the Wisconsin LSC Territory will not be loaded into SWIMS. ENTRY FEES: \$6.00 per individual event, \$12.00 per relay team, \$4.00 splash fee per swimmer and \$3.00 facility fee. Entry fees must accompany entry forms. Recap statement must be complete and the waiver form signed. Money used for reservations is nonrefundable and cannot be used to offset cost of relays, deck seeding or splash fees. The entry fee for deck entries will be \$6.00 for individuals

and \$12.00 for relay teams.. Checks should be made payable to ROCKET AQUATICS.

- WARM-UPS:** **FEET FIRST THREE POINT ENTRY ONLY FROM THE STARTING END OF THE POOL.** The morning and afternoon warm-up sessions will be 50 minutes long, split into two sessions
Host team will assign warm up lanes.
Violators of the Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures may be subject to disqualification.
- SEEDING:** All age groups will be pre-seeded.
- ELIGIBILITY:** All swimmers must be currently registered with United States Swimming and the USA numbers must appear on the entry form/disk. Out of state entrants must bring their USA swimming cards and be prepared to show them to Meet Director. Swimmers wishing to deck enter must have their current USA Swimming ID card available.
- AWARDS:** Individual Events Ribbons – 1st-16th
Heat winner awards will be given for all events for 10 and under age groups. All ribbons and trophies will be available for pick-up by the coaches at the conclusion of the meet. No awards will be mailed.
- ADMISSION:** \$5.00. At the discretion of the host team. Free heat sheets via website (www.WisconsinSwimming.org and www.teamunify.com/wimfsc) or Meet Mobile.
- COACHES PACKETS:** Coaches may pick up their packets in the pool office. Any monies owed must be paid before you can obtain your packet. Please be prepared to show your USA Swimming coaches card at the time you pick up your team packet. Coach's cards must be visible at all times on deck.
- OFFICIAL RULES:** Current USA-SWIMMING AND Wisconsin Swimming Rules shall govern this meet

- DISABLED SWIMMERS:** Please notify meet officials of any disabled swimmers upon arriving at meet.
- FOOD:** A concession stand will offer a wide selection of food and beverages available outside the pool area. **No** food or coolers will be allowed in pool area.
- CONDUCT:** All teams will be responsible for the conduct of their own swimmers. The Meet Marshall and Meet Director shall have authority to disqualify swimmers for misconduct. **NO RECORDING DEVICES ARE PERMITTED IN LOCKER ROOMS.**

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.

- FIRST AID:** A First Aid kit will be available in the pool office.
- LOST&FOUND:** Located in the pool office. After the meet, please contact the meet director. Lost & found will only be held for two weeks after the meet. Any remaining items will then be donated to charity.
- FINAL RESULTS:** Will be posted on the Wisconsin Swimming website and e-mailed to participating teams. They will also be posted in the pool lobby during the meet.
- REST AREA:** The rest area will be restricted to the pool and the hallways adjacent to the pool. Swimmers will not be allowed in other areas of the school.
- SMOKING:** Per USA Swimming rules, smoking is NOT permitted in areas designated for swimmers including the rest areas and pool. Germantown High School is a SMOKE and DRUG FREE ZONE.
- MAAPP POLICY:** Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. An athlete member at a sanctioned meet who is over 18 years of age, who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (APT) by the date of the swim, will not be able to upload into SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.
- COACH'S CREDENTIALS:** Meet Directors/Meet Marshalls or their designee will check coach's credentials that are on the deck for all sanctioned meets. Coaches not in good standing WILL NOT be allowed on the pool deck. They are allowed to be in the spectator stands but NOT on the pool deck. Coach must sign in and show their deck pass.
