**Eligibility:** All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming. USA Swimming deck registration will be accepted.

**Class of Meet:** Open-Timed finals

**Facility** New Berlin Eisenhower has an 8-lane, 25-yard indoor pool with 6" non-turbulent Anti-Wave Line Dividers and backstroke flags. Pool depth ranges from 12 - 8' at the starting end to 4' at the turn end. Starting blocks are Spectrum Single Post Xcellerator with rails and foot-boards; block height is 28 3/4" from the water surface. Depth of pool at the turn end requires 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> leg of 100 yard relays to begin in the water. Timing system is OmniSport 2000 with backup plunger and one manual backup watches per lane. The competition course has not been certified in accord with USA Swimming Rule 1042.2(c).

**MAAP Policy:** All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. An athlete member at a sanctioned meet who is over 18 years of age, who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (APT) by the date of the swim, will not be able to upload into SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.

**COVID: SAFETY PLAN**

This plan is for a sanctioned swim meet using semi-automatic timing competing in 6 available competition lanes and manual back-up timing. Deck officials, coaches, swimmers, and volunteers are asked to be masked if not vaccinated.

**Pool Capacity:** Teams are asked to keep competitors in their designated team areas when not competing. Swimmers wishing to cheer a swimmer may do so at the end of the lane, however, please limit to 3.

<b><u>Health Monitoring:</u></b>	It is expected that all swimmers, coaches, officials, and volunteers are COVID symptom free and without known contact with someone with COVID symptoms or diagnosis within the last 2 weeks. All swimmers, coaches and volunteers entering facility are asked to self-screen. Anyone over 100.4 degree or not feeling well should not enter the facility.
<b><u>Entry and Exit:</u></b>	Athlete drop-off / pick-up is available at the pool entrance near the lower gym. Parking is available at the main building entrance or at near the athletic fields.
<b><u>Locker rooms:</u></b>	<u>Locker rooms will be not be available.</u> Swimmers should be come prepared to participate.
<b><u>Spectators:</u></b>	<u>Spectators are currently permitted inside the pool area for a \$5.00 fee per session</u> (non-participating children 10 & under are free). If this changes, teams will be notified. All spectators are asked to self-monitor their health and not attend if feeling sick or have a fever above 100.4. An outside area is also available. Restroom facilities are available indoors. If the internet works properly, the meet will be live streamed and those wishing to watch are encouraged to do so.
<b><u>Warm-up:</u></b>	A sixty-minute warm-up will take place sixty five minutes prior to the start of sessions 1 & 3. A ten-minute warm-up will take place prior to Session 2. All eight lanes will be available for warmups. Team lanes will be assigned.
<b><u>Deck set-up:</u></b>	Deck marking, and signage will be posted throughout the pool. Hand sanitizing stations and extra disposable face mask will be available upon at the admissions table. Teams are encouraged to provide a mask to swimmers.
<b><u>Coaches</u></b>	All Coaches MUST be USA Swimming registered as of the date of the meet. Please have all coaches check in by presenting their Deck Pass. If a coach does not have a current USA Swimming registration – they CAN NOT be present on the pool deck. If no spectators are allowed during the meet – these unregistered coaches will also NOT be allowed in the spectator stands.
<b><u>Behind the Blocks/Heat Prep Areas:</u></b>	Events will be called by their heat and event. Flyover starts will be permitted at the discretion of the Meet Director and Head Ref., however swimmers must follow the directions of the announcer and meet referee for cues & directions.
<b><u>Staging</u></b>	A staging area for 10 & Under is set up. Coach's should direct those swimmers to the staging 3 - 4 heats prior to the event. Swimmers will be escorted to the blocks for their event.
<b><u>Volunteers and Officials:</u></b>	All officials, coaches, and volunteers are to check-in prior to the meet with the Meet Director.
<b><u>Deck Officials:</u></b>	Stationed per the meet referee's instruction. Wisconsin Officials Rules (2021) will be followed.
<b><u>Administrative Official:</u></b>	Stationed at scoring table.
<b><u>1 - Runner:</u></b>	Delivering timer sheets and DQ notification to the AO and computer operator.
<b><u>12 back-up lane timers:</u></b>	2 backup timer per lane.
<b><u>1 back-up/Head timer:</u></b>	Positioned near the scoring table. Start watch on every race to provide back-up if needed. Mask required.

<b><u>2-3 Swimmer Guides</u></b>	Number depends on size of meet and age of competitors. Duties are to direct and signal swimmers and line them up in preparation for their event.
<b><u>Up to 3 meet marshals:</u></b>	Number depends on size of meet and age of participants. Duties are to enforce social distancing during warm-up and throughout the meet and monitor entry to the facility. Mask required.
<b><u>Event Video Operators</u></b>	Supervise and monitor live stream of the meet.
<b><u>1 Announcer:</u></b>	Stationed at the officials table. Duties include announcing events/heats. Making announcements to swimmers and spectators as needed.
<b><u>1 Timing system Operator:</u></b>	Stationed in the scoring table with view of the finishing end. Responsible for working the scoring system and scoreboard.
<b><u>1-2 Computer Operator:</u></b>	Stationed in the scoring table with a view of finishing end in direct communication with the timing system operator. Responsible for recording & verifying event/heat results with the assistance of the Administrative Official.
<b><u>Schedule/Warm Ups:</u></b>	Session #1 Warm Ups 9:00-10:00 am Session starts: 10:10 am. Warm Up lanes will be assigned. Warm up procedures will be finalized after the close of entries. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
<b><u>Timing System:</u></b>	Daktronics Omnisport 2000
<b><u>Timers</u></b>	Volunteer timers (2 for each lane if possible) will be provided by New Berlin Swim Club.
<b><u>General Rules:</u></b>	Official current USA Swimming and WI LSC rules shall prevail at this meet. Age of October 24, 2021 will dictate swimmer age for the meet.
<b><u>Entry Deadline:</u></b>	<b><u>Entries are due by Oct. 18.</u></b> Email entries to Paul Vincent: <a href="mailto:meetdirector@nbswim.org">meetdirector@nbswim.org</a> . Any updates or modifications must be completed by Oct. 20 <sup>th</sup> (9:00 pm). Waiver forms must be turned prior to the start of warm-ups. No swimmer will be permitted to participate unless a waiver is on file for this meet. Team and swimmer waivers must be on record prior to the beginning of warm-ups.
<b><u>Entry Limit:</u></b>	Swimmers may compete in up to a max of 4 events per session and no more than 6 per day. No relays due to not enough space with timer and swimmers behind the block and social distancing restrictions.
<b><u>Entry Fees:</u></b>	\$4.00 Splash Fee \$5.00 Facility Fee \$5.00 per Event Fee \$12.00 Relay
	<b>Teams are asked to reserve their attendance.</b>
<b><u>Relays:</u></b>	Any changes to relay entries must be submitted to the Meet Director 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. Include ID number, first and last names, age and order of

swim on the relay form in the Coaches packet. All 8 and under 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> relay swimmers will start in the water and will NOT dive into the shallow end for their exchange.

- Swimmers with Disabilities:** Coaches are asked to inform Officials and the Meet Director of any disabled swimmer's needs prior to warm ups.
- Deck Entries:** Deck Entries must be submitted prior to the warm-up of the session.
- Positive Check-In** Any swimmer competing in 400 IM, 500 Freestyle, or 1000 Freestyle need to complete Positive Check-in prior to Event 13 with the Meet Director.
- Coaches Packet:** Please be prepared to show your USA coach's credentials upon arrival. Coach's will receive meet documents that include heat sheets & fee summaries.
- Awards:** Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> places in 12 & Under age groups and mailed to teams.
- Heat Sheet/Admission:** Heat Sheets will be made available to all coach's prior to race day. They will also be published on the NBSC website and Meet Mobile. Paper copies will be available for sale at the admissions table.
- Conduct:** All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves. In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 – the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited. Deck changing is prohibited.
- First Aid:** Report injuries to the lifeguard staff and Meet Director. The Lifeguard staff will assist with first aid.
- Lost and Found:** Lost and found items will be collected at the admissions table.
- Meet Results:** A copy of the meet results will be posted on the New Berlin Swim Club Website and reported to all teams via e-mail. Results will also be posted at [www.wisconsinswimming.org](http://www.wisconsinswimming.org)
