1. Sanction: WI2019-534S

In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

2. Location:

Howard-Suamico Community Pool
Lineville Intermediate School
2700 Lineville Road
Green Bay, WI 54313

3. Facility:

Indoor 25-yard pool with 8 lanes, non-turbulent lane markers, and backstroke flags. The pool depth is 8 feet at starting end and 3.5 at turn end. Block height is 34 inches. The 2nd and 4th leg of all 100-yard relays must start in the water from a push-start due to pool depth.

4. Timing/Judging:

All events will be timed finals. Colorado timing system with touchpads and plunger will be used. There are two manual stopwatches per lane.

5. Official Rules:

Current USA-S and Wisconsin Swimming rules shall govern the conduct of this meet. The no-recall start rule will be in effect.

6. Meet Schedule:

Saturday and Sunday:

Morning Sessions:

- Warm-ups 7:30 a.m.
- Timers meeting 8:15 a.m.
- Meet begins 8:35 a.m.



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Afternoon sessions:

- Warm-ups will begin after the morning session ends, not before 11 a.m.
- Meet will begin 60-minutes after the start of warm-ups.

7. Warm-ups:

Warm-up lanes and times will be assigned for each team, posted on the HSSB website, and included in coaches' packet prior to meet. Three-point entries from the starting end of the pool during general warm-ups will be enforced for all sanctioned/approved competition. There will be two warm-up periods each session, 25 minutes each.

8. Eligibility:

All swimmers must be registered USA-S swimmers and their USA-S number must be listed on the entry file. No "applied for" entries will be accepted. All out-of-state swimmers must be prepared to show their USA-Swimming cards at the request of the meet director. Age is as of November 2, 2019. USA Swimming rules prevail for the meet.

9. Entry Deadline:

All entries must be received no later than Tuesday, 10/22/2019. Please submit entries on HyTek email. Deck entries will be accepted from the coach the day of the meet (provided they do not result in a new heat) up to one half hour prior to the start of each session and will cost \$5 per entry. Please submit meet fees to the meet director at the meet or mail in advance.

10. Entry Limit:

Swimmers may compete in a maximum of 4 individual events per day. Relay entries do not count against the limit.

11. Entry Fees:

- Relays \$12.00
- Deck Seeds \$5.00/event

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13. Final Results:

Final results will be emailed to all participating clubs.

14. Awards:

Awards will consist of medals for 1st-3rd place and ribbons for 4th-16th place for individual events, and ribbons for 1st-5th place for relays. Heat winners will receive awards.

15. Admission:

Admission \$5 for 13 & older and \$3 for senior citizens. A heat sheet fee will be available for \$5 at the door. We will have limited heat sheets for sale at the meet.

Heat sheets will be available for **free** online at www.hssb-wi.org the day before the meet for all attendees to print out.

16. Coaches Note:

All coaches must pick up their coaches' packets in person and must show their current USA-S coaches' card. If a coach does not present a USA-S card they will not be allowed on deck and the swimmers from that team will be assigned a USA-S certified coach for warm-ups.

17. Concessions:

A comprehensive concessions menu will be available during the meet. Concession items must be consumed in designated areas.

18. Conduct:

Each club is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers. All teams please keep your area as clean as possible.

In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 – the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated area is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches,



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officials, and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.

MAAPP POLICY: Pursuant to Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. mandate, all applicable adults participating or associated with respective meet to which this information applies, acknowledge that they are an applicable adult, subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand the compliance with the MAAPP Policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
