Effective 11/6/2019 times achieved by an athlete member at a sanctioned meet who is over 18 years of age (+30 day grace period) who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (or whose APT training had expired) by the date of the swim, will not be able to be uploaded to the SWIMS.

Ashwaubenon Swim Club taken enhanced health and safety measures for guests, participants, and meet staff. You must follow all instructions while visiting the Ashwaubenon Community Pool. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious virus that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and guests with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By visiting Ashwaubenon Community Pool, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

USA Swimming, Inc., cannot prevent you (or your child(ren)) from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while participating in USA Swimming sanctioned events. It is not possible to prevent the presence of the virus, regardless of safety precautions. Therefore, if you choose to participate in a USA Swimming sanctioned event, you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

RULES:

- 1) All participants must adhere to the meet marshalls' instructions and signage in the Ashwaubenon Community Pool facility.
- 2) Masking and social distancing may be required depending on the facility COVID rules at the time of the meet. Information will be provided by the host team the week of the meet.
- 3) COVID waivers must be completed by all swimmers before they will be allowed to race. COVID waivers also need to be completed by all athletes, volunteers, coaches. An electronic waiver will be available online a few days before the meet.
- 4) Any participants not abiding by the rules could be asked to leave the Ashwaubenon Community Pool facility. Refunds on meet entries will not be provided.

Saturday morning sessions: Warm ups are 2- 25 minute sessions starting at 7:00 AM with a meet start at 8:05 AM. There will be a 20 min in-water break before the 500.

Saturday afternoon sessions: Warm ups will begin following the completion of the morning session. 2- 25 minute sessions.

Sunday morning sessions: Warm ups are 2- 25 minute sessions starting at 7:00 AM with meet start at 8:05 AM. There will be a 20 min in-water break before the 1000.

Location: Ashwaubenon Community Swimming Pool 2391 S Ridge Road Ashwaubenon, WI 54304

Facility: The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). 8 lane, 25 yard, backstroke flags at 5 yards from each end, Non Turbulence lane dividers, 29" Xcellerator starting block with starting wedge. Starting depth is 12' 6" with the turn side depth at 4'. Colorado Timing System with backup stop watch and plungers. Additionally, a 4 lane warm up/warm down pool is adjacent. Locker rooms will be open.

Entry Fees: \$4 Splash Fee per swimmer & \$5 Facility Fee per swimmer
\$5 per event & \$15 per relay

Admission: \$5 per person. At this time, there are no spectator restrictions. This is subject to change depending on facility rules at the time of the meet.

Heat Sheets: Will be available the day prior to the meet online at www.ascwi.com. No heat sheets will be sold. A session report including timelines for each session will be sent out to participating teams.

500- The 500 will be pre-seeded fastest to slowest. Participants should provide a counter.
1000- The 1000 will be pre-seeded fastest to slowest. Participants should provide a counter.

Deck Entries: Will not be accepted. All entries must be received by deadline.

Entry Limits: Each swimmer may enter 4 individual events on Saturday and 3 individual events on Sunday, plus relays each day.

Meet Limits: 200 athletes for each session on Sat. 250 athletes total for Sunday session. The meet host may also place additional swimmer limits per session if required by the Village of Ashwaubenon. The meet host also reserves the right to limit entries from teams if the meet becomes too large based on the projected timeline to comply with the 4-hour rule or potential COVID limits. Once your entries are accepted, you will receive a confirmation email from our entry coordinator. Please submit your entries early to assure your team's entry to this meet as it may fill early.

Hy-Tek File: An events file will be published through Wisconsin Swimming and sent to area teams.

Entries: Entries October 1-6, 2021- First come basis. All entries due October 6. Via email, Send entry file, meet entry report and meet fee report. Please deliver a meet waiver and meet fees check to the computer table prior to the start of the meet.

Entrants: Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member

coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Further, those participants not proficient with a backstroke ledge must start each race from within the water, and without use of the backstroke ledge.

Swimmers with Disabilities: Please indicate special needs on waiver form and communicate to the head official 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.

Warm Ups: The host will send warm up assignments by lane to the participating teams the week of the meet.

Safety Marshall: Feet first three-point entries from the side of the pool will be enforced at the start of each warm up session by a safety marshall with warnings of violations given to the certified coach on deck. If the situation warrants, safety marshals may remove from the deck for the remainder of the warm up session any swimmer or coach who is in violation of safety guidelines or warm up procedures.

Warm up Pool: Adjacent pool may be offered throughout the meet for warm up and warm down swimming only. We will put out information on warm up pool availability as we get closer to the meet. If lifeguard or safety marshall deems swimmer conduct warrants closing the warm up pool, it will close.

Concessions: will be available during the meet

Illness: Swimmers/spectators and coaches who are feeling ill should not enter the building or participate in the meet. Anyone who has had COVID or suspected COVID should not attend the meet. Anyone who has a close contact or a household member with known/suspected COVID should not attend unless they have a negative COVID test 7 days after exposure. Anyone who is waiting for a COVID test result should not attend. These rules are subject to change depending on current state/CDC guidelines at the time of the meet.

Sanitization: The Ashwaubenon Pool Staff will be sanitizing and cleaning common areas such as restrooms, doorknobs, bleachers throughout the meet

First Aid: is available during the meet in the pool office or from the lifeguard on duty.

Awards:

Individual Events: Medals 1-3rd and ribbons 4th-16th for age groups as listed on the page below

Relays: Ribbons 1st-6th

Awards will be bagged and teams can pick them up at the end of the meet. Awards will not be mailed.

Final Results: Results will be available on Meet Mobile, and each team will receive a High-tech results file and a copy of the final results.

Meet Conduct: All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and must see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Coaches sponsoring unattached athletes are responsible for the conduct of those athletes. Meet Marshals with the concurrence of the Meet Director or Meet Referee have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. In accordance with the Federal Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004-the use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones and MP3 players is, prohibited in the locker rooms, rest rooms, or changing areas. Teams, swimmers, and spectators should pick up and properly dispose of garbage. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in the locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. The use of drones during meets (without prior approval) is prohibited. Glass containers are not allowed on the pool deck.

Lost and Found: Swimmers are responsible for their belongings. Lost & found articles will be located in the pool office.

Rules: Official current USA Swimming and Wisconsin LSC rules shall prevail at this meet. USA Swimming membership is required for deck access. Coaches and officials should display their USA Swimming card when on the pool deck or be able to produce credentials upon request. Non-athlete members are only allowed on deck for official business. Deck Pass is an acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
