



Shorewood Swim Club Volunteer Policy Est. 2/20/2020

Short Course Sept – March	Long Course: March-August

When you register your child(ren) with the Shorewood Swim Club (SSC), you are making a volunteer commitment to the Club. This SSC volunteer policy outlines this commitment. With every family doing its part, the Club can operate successfully and help your swimmers have a meaningful athletic experience. Hosting meets is roughly 20% of the clubs revenue, and is pivotal in keeping our registration fees at a reasonable rate. We can't fully operate our club without the help of the parents/families.

Shorewood Swim Club Volunteer Policy

The Shorewood Swim Club requires families (Age Group Bronze, Silver, Gold, HSP, JR, SR-Red, and SR-Blue) to volunteer at SSC-hosted meets. 12&U Families are required to volunteer 3 times for both the short course and long course season. 13&O families are required to work 2 times during the short course season and 3 times during the long course season.

Families with kids in swim league are *only* required to volunteer at SSC swim meets if their child is participating in the meet.

Short Course Season	13&O: 2 Sessions at January IMX; 12&U 3 Total Sessions
Fall Only	12&U: 1 Session at November Meet
Winter Only	12&U: 2 Sessions at January IMX Meet 13&O: 2 Sessions at January IMX Meet
Long Course Season	13&O: 3 Sessions at June Meet Only; 12&U: 3 Total Sessions
Spring Only	12&U: 1 Session in April, 2 sessions at June Meet. 13&O: 3 Sessions at June Meet
Summer Only	12&U: 3 Sessions at June Meet 13&O: 3 Sessions at June Meet

****See Note above about Swim League Family Volunteer Obligations**

Families with multiple swimmers follow the volunteer policy based on the highest volunteer requirement. **Example:** If a family has 2 swimmers during the Short Course Season (1 swimmer is 10, 1 swimmer is 14), then such family follows the requirement of 10 year old, 3 sessions total.

- At the end of a season, if an enrolled SSC swimmer's family does not volunteer the minimum required sessions, SSC will assess a \$75 per missed session fee. These missed sessions **cannot be made-up in subsequent seasons**; SSC will add this fee to the families' online account.
- If a volunteer does not show the day of our meet after previously signing up to work, you will incur a \$150 fine.
- The SSC Board and Executive Committee has the discretion to give a family volunteer credit for other work done on the club's behalf or to grant any exceptions to the policy based on proof of extenuating circumstances.
