<p>Facility</p>	<p>Indoor 25 yard pool with eight 7' lanes, non-turbulent lane markers, backstroke flags, 32" Paragon quick start slanted starting blocks, guttered pool. Pool depth is 12' at the starting block end and 3 ½' at the opposite end. Either 6 lanes (with lane 7 closed, lane 8 for warmup/cooldown) or 8 lanes will be used for competition, as determined by the meet directors based on the number of entries.</p> <p>The Competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(C).</p>	
<p>Timing</p>	<p>All events will be timed using a Colorado System 6 with Strobe/Horn Start, Touch pads, one button, and 2 watches as backup. All 25-yard races will be timed with 2 buttons and 2 watches. All events will be timed finals.</p>

<p>Entry Deadline</p>	<p>Entries are due by Wednesday, September 22nd; files may be updated (and may include new entries) through Friday, October 1st.</p>	
<p>Entry Limit</p>	<p>Swimmers may swim up to five individual events and one relay per session.</p>	

Deck Entries	Deck entries must be able to prove their USA Swimming membership. There are no additional fees for deck-entered swimmers after the initial meet entry fees.
Official Rules	Current USA and Wisconsin Swimming Rules shall govern this meet. All swimmers must hold current USA Swimming registration.
Racing Start Certification	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement
Warm-Ups	Warmup assignments will be listed on the website and sent to team reps by the Tuesday of the meet.
Age Groups	Events will have swimmers grouped together by gender and age, but will be split apart to single-age/single-gender categories for results.
Seeding	Deck seeding will only be used to fill heats already created. Events run fast to slow.
Staging	2-3 heats will be permitted behind the blocks; staging will not be utilized by Storm
Positive Check In	Positive check in will be utilized for the 500 freestyle and 400 IM.
Fly-Over Starts	Fly-over starts will be used.
Awards	Ribbons will be given 1 st through 6 th in single age divisions. High point awards will be given based to 1 st place for single age in classifications below based on combined time. There will be no high point awards for events not listed in the NAG Motivational Times sheet.
Admission	No admission will be charged at the event; \$9.00 per swimmer fee is included in meet entries
Heat Sheets	Free, online
Livestream	Link will be available on the Storm Home Meets page
Concessions	Concessions and hospitality will be provided
Deck Changing	Deck changing is prohibited.
Meet Conduct	In accordance with USA Swimming rules, NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK. In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited. Coaches must show current USA Swimming credentials while on deck. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.
MAAPP	Pursuant to Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. mandate, all applicable adults participating or associated with respective meet to which this information applies, acknowledge that they are an applicable adult, subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand the compliance with the MAAPP Policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. An athlete member at a sanctioned meet who is over 18 years of age, who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (APT) by the date of the swim, will not be able to upload into SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.
