**GENERAL INFORMATION**

December 2-3, 2022 at Greenfield High School (4800 S 60th St, Greenfield, WI 53220)

Admission will be \$5 per person 12+. All admission is cashless and managed by Ticket Spicket. A link will be posted on the SWAT website and QR codes will be posted at the pool.

Heat sheets will be available to print at no cost on the SWAT website. Hard copies WILL NOT be available at the pool.

Greenfield HS is an 8-lane, 25-yard pool with a depth of 12'4" at the start end and 3'6" at the turn end. The competition course HAS NOT been certified in accordance with USA Swimming Rule 104.2.2C(4). Meet management has the right to use less than 8 lanes for competition. Lane 1 may be used for socially distanced warm-up/cool-down if needed. The starting blocks are 30" high.

All 25-yard races will start from the start end of the pool and use one watch as the official time. A backup button may be available if technology allows. Please be advised that due to the depth of the non-starting end of the pool, the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> leg of all 100 yard/meter relays will start in the water.

**MEET FORMAT**

The following age groups will be used for scoring and awards: 6 and under, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and Open.

All of Friday's events will be positive check events and will be seeded on Friday evening before the start of the meet. Check-in will close at 6:00 PM on Friday 12/2/22. These events will be conducted fast to slow, alternating girls and boys heats. These events may be combined by any age/gender at the discretion of meet management.

Relays will be removed from the meet and entry fees refunded if required to meet the four-hour session rule. Relay listings are due to the Entry Chair before the start of the session. Any changes to relays must be indicated on the relay entry form.

## **ENTRY INFORMATION**

Athletes may participate in a maximum of two (2) events on Friday and four (4) events on Saturday, plus relays. Athlete's age is determined as of December 2, 2022

Individual Event Entry Fee: \$5.00 per event

Relay Event Entry Fee: \$12.00 per event

Deck Seed Individual Event Entry Fee: \$20 per event

Deck Seed Relay Event Entry Fee: \$20 per event

WI LSC Splash Fee: \$4.00 per athlete

Entries must be submitted via e-mail in Hy-Tek format. *Entries must be received no later than 8:00 PM on Monday, November 28th.* Coaches may provide updated times through 8:00 PM on Wednesday, November 30th. Additional entries will be accepted if space allows. The meet will be seeded on Wednesday evening. All entries after that point will be deck entries if space allows.

Warm-up will begin 10 minutes after end of AM session.

Timed finals will begin 75 minutes after end of AM session

Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect. Meet management may assign warm-up lanes if needed. Feet-first, three-point entry from the starting end during warm-ups will be enforced unless performing one-way sprints. Violators of the Wisconsin Swimming Warm-Up procedures may be subject to disqualification.

## **AWARDS**

Individual Events: Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> place for all 12 and under swimmers.

Relay Events: Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> place for all 12 and under relays.

***No awards for 13 and older swimmers.***

Heat Winners: Prizes for each heat winner in all races.

No team scores will be kept at the meet. Awards will be bagged and distributed at the end of the meet.

## **RESULTS**

Meet results will be e-mailed to the person identified as the entry contact at the conclusion of the meet.

Results will also be posted to the SWAT website and submitted to Wisconsin Swimming for posting on their website and entry into the SWIMS database.

## **RULES AND PROCEDURES**

Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), will govern this meet. A registered athlete member at a sanctioned/approved meet who is 18 years of age or older, who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (APT) by the date of the swim, will not be able to upload into SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered “not in good standing” and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.

Current USA and Wisconsin LSC Rules shall prevail for this meet. Swimmers must be registered USA Swimming athletes. Athlete age will be determined as of December 2, 2022

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Please communicate any special requirements and/or requests for a swimmer with a disability or a spectator with a disability with the Meet Director before the start of the meet.

All coaches must have current, valid USA Swimming credentials in order to be on deck. Deck Pass is a valid form of identification.

Each team is responsible for the conduct of its athletes. The Meet Director or Meet Marshal may remove any swimmer from the competition for disruptive or disorderly behavior. Teams are financially responsible for damage to the facility or property.

In accordance with the Federal Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004, the use of cell phones, cameras, or video recording devices in the locker rooms is strictly prohibited. Photography and the use of cell phones is also prohibited behind the starting blocks.

The restrooms and locker rooms in the pool area are for athletes only. Spectators are NEVER allowed in the athlete locker room areas.

The restrooms in the lobby area are for spectators only. Athletes should use the restrooms in the pool area. Changing into or out of swimsuits in areas other than the locker rooms is not appropriate and prohibited. DECK CHANGING IS NOT ALLOWED.

Teams are kindly requested to clean up their immediate areas at the conclusion of each session.

Injuries must be reported to the lifeguard and Meet Director immediately. First aid supplies will be available at the lifeguard station.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Vice President of Program Operations, operation of a drone or other flying apparatus is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) at any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.
