

## SWAT COVID-19 Quarantine & Fee Credit Policy

- 1) Any swimmer that has possible COVID-19 symptoms should stay home. Contact your primary care doctor for guidance on getting tested.
- 2) If a swimmer tests positive or is notified of exposure to COVID-19 through school or contact tracing, SWAT follows the documentation provided from the local health department/school/physician as to the number of practices a swimmer is required to miss due to their circumstances.
- 3) Swimmers missing four consecutive practices due to this policy will receive a prorated fee credit up to two weeks. In the event a swimmer's illness or quarantine is longer than two weeks, refer to SWAT's regular medical exemption policy. Documentation of test results or quarantine directive are required.
- 4) Notification & Communication : When a swimmer tests positive for COVID-19, only those swimmers that have been determined to have had prolonged close contact with that swimmer will be notified and asked to quarantine. The determination will be made with the appropriate local Health Department. A general teamwide communication may or may not be made.
