

Instructions to Complete Safe Sport Education Training

Dear Athletes AND Parents,

Please take the free USA Swimming sponsored “Safe Sport” online training course. Athletes must take “Safe Sport for Athletes” and parents must take “Parent’s Guide to Misconduct in Sport.” This really is important, and the team requires it in order to become Safe Sport Recognized. Please help us get there.

First, **SWIMMERS or OFFICIALS** must make sure that they have a registered “Deck Pass” login at the USA Swimming website. **PARENTS** who are not officials can skip to page 2 of the instructions.

You will be given the following two options:

1. If your swimmer is already registered with a USA Swimming Deck Pass, they should log-in to their account on the left side.
2. If your swimmer does not have a USA Swimming Deck Pass account, they should use the “Register” option on the left.
 - a. Complete the registration process, including creating a username and password. Save this information for future use on the USA Swimming website.

Once your USA Swimming Deck Pass account has been set-up and you are logged in, proceed to the next step on page 2.


I am a USA Swimming Member

USA Swimming LEARN is the online education hub for all members of USA Swimming! LEARN stands for Leadership Education And Resource Network. USA Swimming LEARN provides multi-dimensional educational and resource opportunities for athletes, coaches, parents, and officials at all levels of swimming. The goal of LEARN is to provide a consistent and quality learning experience across multiple disciplines for all USA Swimming members in order to develop new skills and enhance their experience inside and out of the pool.

Your time is valuable! USA Swimming LEARN's online course platform features a mobile responsive design to allow you to access high-quality education whether you're at home, on the road, or at the pool.

Scroll down and enter your first name, last name, and date of birth, then click "search"

Your name and club code will appear below the search button. Click "Continue"

You will then need to click on "GO TO LEARN." That will bring you to the ATHLETE PROTECTION TRAINING portal.

You may be asked to update your profile (enter your email, LSC and club name).

You will be told your profile has been updated and you may move to other pages. Look at the bar at the top of the screen:

Enter your information. Click "REGISTER"

Be sure to select "WISCONSIN SWIMMING" as the LSC and "WAUKESHA EXPRESS SWIM TEAM" as the Club Name

The site will welcome you and tell you that you have not started any courses. Click "COURSES"

You will see a number of courses available (below).

1. If you are an **athlete**, under “**Safe Sport for Athletes**” click “ADD TO CART”
If you are a **parent**, under “**Parent’s Guide to Misconduct in Sport**” click “ADD TO CART” It will display a checkmark, and say “IN CART”



Click on the shopping cart at the top right of the screen and “CHECKOUT”.

You will be required to enter your name and address, but NOT billing information. There is no charge. Complete the required information and click “Next Step”

On the next screen, click “Place Order”

Now go to “DASHBOARD” and “START” your course.

Click “Next” to proceed from segment to segment. The athlete course takes about 15 minutes. The Parent course takes between 30-40 minutes.
