- Location:** Marquette Senior High School
1203 W. Fair Ave.
Marquette, MI 49855
- Facility:** 25 yard pool, six lanes, Colorado timing system with six-lane digital scoreboard, backstroke flags, starting platforms and poolside balcony for spectator seating. Locker rooms, concessions and team camp areas are available.
- Meet Schedule:** Friday warm up: 5:30-6:00 pm open lanes, meet starts at 6:15 pm EST
Events 1-11 are Friday night.
Saturday warm up: 7:30 -9:00 am by assignment
Meet starts at 9:15am
There will be a minimum of 20 minute break after morning session ends before start of afternoon session
Events 100-163 are Saturday.
- Entries:** Entries are due: **Noon, Monday, March 2, 2020**
Deck entries accepted at discretion of meet official and entered into open lanes only with no reseeding.

Team waiver and payment due at start of meet.
- Age Division:** Swimmer's age as of December 1, 2019 determines age group
Age groups for awards 6 and under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14
Open Events may be combined with multiple age groups/ genders.
Results will be separated for awards and scoring.
Minimum age for Open events is 11.
- Disabled Swimmers** Coaches are encouraged to inform the meet director or head referee of any special needs for a swimmer during warm ups or the meet.
- Entry Limits:** Swimmers are limited to 7 individual events, plus 2 relays.
- Entry Cost:** \$5.00 per individual event and \$16.00 per relay team.
Deck Entries are \$7.50 per event.
Time Trial events are \$10 per event.
Marquette Area Public Schools also charges \$3/athlete facility use fee that is due as part of the entry. One check for your team should be made payable to: **Wildcat Aquatics Club.**
- Events:** USA Swimming technical rules will prevail for the meet.
The 2nd/ 4th swimmers for all 8 & under relays will start in the pool.
Flyover starts will be used.
All events are timed finals and will be pre-seeded and swum slowest to fastest with the exception of the 500/1000/1650 free. These events will be swum fastest to slowest. Swimmers in the 1650 and 1000 must provide their own back-up timer.
There will be a 10 minute warm up before the 1000 on Friday night and the 500 on Saturday.
Events may be combined to minimize empty lanes/ heats.
- Time Trials:** Following the conclusion of the scheduled meet, there will be a time trial session offered, intended for swimmers attempting to qualify for state/

regional or national meets. Time trial events are \$10 per entry and must be approved by the swimmer's head coach. Events 200y or less only- no distance events. Different strokes of the same distance may be swum concurrently.

- Marshalling:** Deck space is limited. Swimmers, coaches, volunteers and officials only are allowed on the pool deck. A marshalling area will be set up on the south side of the pool for 8 & under events only. All other events can report directly to the starting blocks. Swimmers are discouraged from gathering behind the starting blocks more than 5 minutes before the start of their event.
- Results:** Results will be posted in the hallway outside the pool between boys' and girls' lockerrooms. They will also be available in real time on the Meet Mobile App. Result file and pdf will be mailed out after the meet.
- Awards:** Medals 1st-3rd, Ribbons: 4th thru 6th places, also heat winner awards All awards will be packaged and given to teams at the end of the meet. Awards will NOT be mailed.
- Scoring:** All events will be separated by Age Group for scoring and awards as follows: 6 & under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & over. Age Groups will swim together in heats.
- Concessions:** Food and drink will be available for purchase in the highschool cafeteria.
- Admission:** Admission is free. Heat sheets will be posted online. A limited number will be available for sale.
- Conduct:** Clubs are responsible for the conduct of swimmers and parents who are required to follow instructions from meet officials. The meet director has the authority to disqualify swimmers found misbehaving. In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism act the use of camera phones or video recording devices in locker rooms is prohibited.
ONLY COACHES, ATHLETES, OFFICIALS AND MEET VOLUNTEERS ARE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK.
- Misc.:** Limited lockers available. Swimmers are responsible for their own belongings. The Wildcat Aquatics Club, YMCA of Marquette County and Marquette Area Public Schools assume no responsibility for lost or stolen articles.
