## 2022 CCS 11-14 All-Star “Catch the Spirit Camp”

April 3, 2022 ~ Clovis North Aquatic Center, Fresno, CA

- Time:** Athlete drop-off - **Sunday, April 3, 2022** at 9:00am on the pool deck of the Clovis North Aquatic Center  
Athlete pick-up – **Sunday, April 3, 2022** at 3 pm on the pool deck of the Clovis North Aquatic Center.
- Location:** **CLOVIS NORTH AQUATICS COMPLEX (CLOVIS NORTH HIGH SCHOOL).** 2770 E International Ave. Fresno, CA 93730. Highway 41 or 99 to Herndon Avenue, east on Herndon to Willow, north on Willow to the corner of Willow & International. Continue on Willow to the east end of the campus and turn left at the tennis courts. Drop off at the pool entrance and continue to Chestnut (left) and left into the parking lot.
- Facilities:** 50 M x 25 yard pool. The main competition pool is all deep at 7 feet. The competition pool has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 C (4). The copy of such is on file with USA Swimming. Clovis North High School will also provide classroom, auditorium, and dryland space. Clovis hotel accommodations are pending.
- Rules:** All swimmers currently registered with USA Swimming for 2022. Deck Pass is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.  
Use of audio or visual recordings devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.  
Propane heaters are prohibited. Deck changes are prohibited.  
No Competition Awards will be presented.  
For Athlete Protection, Central California Swimming prohibits the use of photography and audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, behind the starting blocks during the start sequence throughout the event.  
Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.  
All USAS athlete members must be under the supervision of a USAS member coach or chaperone during the event.  
Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

**All Team CCS athletes, chaperones, and coaches will be required to stay with the team throughout the trip. Swimmers with a disability who require special care will be required to travel with a parent or other designated adult. Swimmers will not be allowed to leave the team until Sunday April 19, and only to their parents, legal guardian, or designated adult who must sign the swimmer out. Please thoroughly read the Athlete Code of Conduct found in the application packet.**

- Camp Details: CCS will be selecting an All-Star team of 11-14 year olds to participate in the CCS sponsored, USA Swimming "LSC Select Camp" in Clovis, CA, **April 3**. Parents will check-in their athletes on deck at Clovis North Aquatic Center on Sunday at 9 am, April 3. This camp includes pool sessions aimed at getting the best in CCS together to train and race, 2 educational classroom sessions, team building exercises, **and a motivational speech and pool technique session with Two Time Team USA Olympian (Rio 2016, Open Water and Pool) 2015 World Champion, 10k Open Water- Jordan Wilimovsky!**
- Application: Applications will be available on the CCS website and will be distributed at the CCS Short Course Junior Olympics in Fresno, February 18-21, 2022. All CCS swimmers 11-14 who have ANY AA times are encouraged to apply for selection to the 2020 All Star Camp. **All applications are due by FRIDAY MARCH 4TH.** Swimmers who do not have any AA times are welcome to apply; however, priority will be given to athletes who meet the AA time standard in multiple events.
- Selection Criteria: There will be 40 athletes selected for this Camp. Age Group will be determined upon age of the athlete as of the first day of the camp, April 2, 2022.
1. Swimmers in each age group will be selected by the Camp Coordinator and the Camp Head Coach based on the USA Swimming Motivational "AA" Time Standard. Qualifying times shall be the swimmer's best time from April 1, 2020 through the application deadline, and be listed as officially verified times in the USA Swimming database.
  2. Swimmers with the most AA times will be selected first. If there are not enough applicants with AA times to complete the team, then:
  3. Swimmers with the highest Hy-Tek Power Point single event in the USA Swimming database.
- Fees: There will be a \$150 deposit due at the time of application. If the applying athlete is not selected, the \$150 deposit will be refunded to the payee. There will be no further money due upon selection to this camp.
- Additional Info: Athletes will be responsible for delivering the following items to the Camp Coordinator with the application on the application deadline, **FRIDAY MARCH 4<sup>TH</sup>, 2022.**
1. Completed and signed Medical Release (with a copy of your health insurance card)
  2. Signed Code of Conduct
- Supervision: There will be 5 adults in direct supervision of the athletes in all activities involved in the camp. There will be at least 3 coaches selected to coach this event (1 head coach and 2 supporting assistant coaches). There will be 2 chaperones selected from applications from the parents of attending athletes. Chaperones will be

selected and coordinated by the Camp Coordinator. All parent chaperones will be non-athlete members of USA Swimming and have cleared both the USA Swimming background check and Athlete Protection Training.
