

COLORADO SWIMMING – Posting

Role: Aquatic Facility Development Consultant/Liaison

Duties of the Role:

- 1.) Represent Colorado Swimming in the planning and development of a world-class aquatic facility with the Reunion Sports Complex. (Located near C-470 and 104th.)
- 2.) Participate as a member of the Reunion Pool Development Committee.
- 3.) Recommend specifications that would benefit the Colorado Swimming community. Emphasis is on an indoor long course pool, which will improve our meets by providing separate warm up/warm down, the ability to start at both ends and ample seating for spectators.
- 4.) Recommend programming opportunities in cooperation with Colorado Swimming, USA Swimming and local clubs.
- 5.) Utilize USA Swimming staff and resources for facility development as needed.
- 6.) Provide all relevant information and updates to the Colorado Swimming BOD over the course of the project. (Estimated to be 4-5 years)
- 7.) The Consultant/Liaison may be asked to also give insight and advice on other Competitive Pool venues that occur within the Colorado LSC.

Role Span: 4-5 years beginning in 2019

Compensation Consideration:

Currently the Role is under development. As of May 2019, This role is very much in it's infancy as it relates to understanding the full commitments that will be entered into by CSI and the person filling this position due to how early in the complex development the process is to date. The person accepting this role agrees to work with the CSI Executive committee to plan an ongoing Strategy and with that a commitment/compensation plan (should it need to change) in order to gain CSI BoD approval for ongoing role activity. The Board has discussed compensation options (Payment of travel Expenses and/or a stipend) to get started in the role and will clarify those options as the Role becomes more defined.
