Section A: Junior Meet Referee

After being certified as a Deck Referee, the official may be approved to work in the capacity of Meet Referee for timed finals meets of 300 swimmers or less. This position is referred to as a Junior Meet Referee. Before this is possible, the Deck Referee must shadow a Senior Meet Referee for at least 1 meet and receive a recommendation to work as a Junior Meet Referee. Sessions worked at small meets, while in the presence of a Senior Meet Referee, contribute toward advancement to the position of Senior Meet Referee if verified in Section B of this log.

Deck Referee qualified to work as a Junior Meet Referee (Timed Finals meets with less than 300 swimmers).

Section B: Senior Meet Referee

Prerequisites: to become eligible to advance to Senior Meet Referee, an official must have been a certified Deck Referee for at least twelve (12) months and have served 12 sessions at the Deck Referee position. In addition, the official must have served as a Junior Meet Referee for five (5) meets. Verification of standing by the Official's Coordinator is also required.

Requirements: Trainee must attend an in-person CSI sponsored Meet Referee clinic. After completion of the prerequisites, the trainee must shadow at least three (3) different Senior Meet Referees for a minimum of twelve (12) sessions in the course of three (3) meets, one of which must be a Prelim/Final meet (to be accomplished within 18 months.) At least one meet must be out of the official's zone. The trainee shall then work as Co-Meet Referee with a Senior Meet Referee for a minimum of two (2) meets. The trainee must be an active member of a CJ team at a Prelim/Final meet for four (4) sessions and shadow an Administrative Referee at a Prelim/Final National Scratch Rule meet for a minimum of 1 day.

Certification at this level may be granted upon completion of the above requirements and receipt of favorable recommendations from three (3) Senior Meet Referees. The Officials Chair must certify the completion of the training with the recommendation of their CSI Zone Officials Representative.

Before being certified as a Senior Meet Referee, the candidate must receive 3 recommendations.
