

2020-2021 MMSC Parent Contract

The Mighty Marlin Swim Club is a 501(c) 3 non-profit organization and in order to off-set operation costs, we rely on fundraising/parent volunteer to help keep membership dues down.

Monthly Dues: On the 1st of each month, an invoice will be mailed to you with your current monthly dues which must be paid by the 10th of each month. Payments received after the 10th of the month will be assessed a \$10.00 late fee and swimming privileges may be rescinded. There will be a \$25.00 fee assessed for all NSF checks. _____

Any missed swim hours are forfeited and may not be made up

Withdrawal from Team/Termination: If you need to terminate your membership, you must notify the Treasurer in writing (email is sufficient) 15 days prior to the next billing cycle. A swimmer, who participates in any practices within that month, is responsible for the full monthly fee. We reserve the right to terminate a swimmer/family at any time based on our code of conduct. _____

Throughout our 2020-2021 swim season, each family will be **required** to participate in the following fundraising/volunteer requirements. **If you terminate your membership at any time during the swim season, you are still required to pay the following amounts:**

- _____ **Swim-A-Thon:** Each family is **required** to raise \$100.00 per swimmer/\$200.00 per family

Volunteer Hours:

MMSC is a volunteer-run swim club and parent volunteering is critical to the overall financial health and operation of the team. Swim meets hosted by MMSC generate team revenue necessary to meet operation costs not covered by the monthly dues. By requiring volunteer participation, we ensure that our budgeted operational needs are met, and our monthly dues are kept down.

- _____ Each Family is required to work a minimum of 22.5 hours (Sept. 2020-August 2021). It is highly recommended that you work the session in each home meet that your swimmer is participation in.
- _____ Families who join MMSC later in the swim season will have their volunteer hours pro-rated.
- _____ At the end of the swim season, families who do not fulfill their volunteer obligation, will be assessed a \$20.00 fee per unfulfilled hour up to a total of \$600.00.

- _____ Termination of membership anytime during our 2020-2021 swim season, volunteer hours will be assessed in quarterly increments as follows:

~~September 1st thru November 30th - 7.5 volunteer hours~~

December 1st thru February 28th - 7.5 volunteer hours

March 1st thru May 31st - 7.5 volunteer hours

June 1st thru August 31st - 7.5 volunteer hours

(For example: termination on January 20th; required completed volunteer hours=15 hours. Failure to work a minimum of 15 hours will result in a \$20.00 charge per un-worked volunteer hour. 15 x \$20.00= \$300.00)

Due to COVID-19 and the ability to host meets, volunteer hours will be evaluated on a quarterly basis

- _____ **This 2020-2021 season, MMSC will host PNS Long Course Age Group Champs in Federal Way at KCAC: Friday-Sunday, July 30-August 1, 2021. Each family must work a minimum of 10 hours at this meet. Failure to complete the entire minimum 10 hours will result in a fine of \$200.**

Volunteer Opportunities: All volunteer sign-up opportunities will take place on our team website to receive service credit. All volunteers are responsible for signing in at MMSC hosted events at the clerk of the course table with the meet director to receive credit for hours worked. Volunteers who work at other events (another clubs swim meet as a timer) are responsible for notifying the Treasurer of the hours worked. All volunteer hours are recorded and tracked on our website. Each family has access to their own account and can monitor their volunteer hours at any time.

- Volunteer at Marlins-hosted swim meets
- Stroke and Turn Official- become certified and help officiate at all swim meets
- Timing at “away” meets
- Volunteer at Marlins special events: Swim-a-thon, Fun Runs, Committees, etc...
