



Swimmer Recognition

Championship Teams:

Swimmers will receive an item that the board approves for the following 3 teams throughout the year. Swimmers must have an individual cut that meets the requirements for the lowest meet of that time period (ex. Must have a winter age group cut during winter). They can also be a part of a relay to receive the item if and only if that swimmer was part of the relay at a qualifying meet and the relay time for the championship meet was earned. Relay only swimmers added to WAG/JAG will receive a goodie bag, but not the item or the bag tag. If a swimmer has more than one cut for the defined season (ex. Swimmer has earned WAG/Sectional/ etc), they will only receive the 1 item as a swimmer provided by the team for the defined TMEC Championship team.

****If Southern California Swimming allocates money to swimmers/coaches for an event/meet (ex. Futures or higher), TMEC will match what SCS allocates per swimmer to the swimmer family to help pay for travel expenses.*

***Goodie bags (AKA Invite Bags) and bag tags are only given out for Winter and Summer Championship Teams*

Announcements on Team Unify/Emails:

A “News” announcement will be written for swimmers or an individual swimmer for the following reasons. (Board or coaches could announce other items not listed as well.)

- A. Results of all participating swimmers at EACH meet
 - a. making best attempt to note any personal bests of each swimmer, team records broken or medal wins at Committee Championships/Invites/JO’s/etc. With provided photos (if available)
- B. Being selected to an All-Star Event
 - a. SCS All-Star Festival (around January)
 - b. SCS Pacific Coast All-Star (PAC) (January)
 - c. North American Cup Challenge (NACC) (if returned to schedule) (Summer)
 - d. Western Zones All Starts (Summer)
- C. Being Selected to a USA Swimming Camp/Event
 - a. Western Zone Selected Camp
 - b. Diversity Camp
 - c. Junior National Team
 - d. Other USA swimming invite only camps
- D. Signing with a college to continue swim
- E. Breaking a record
 - a. Southern California Record
 - b. National Age Group Record
- F. Being Selected to the SCS Banquet
 - a. Top 3 time in an event in SCS 10 & Unders
 - b. Top 10 time in an event in the United States (11 & older)
- G. Achieving the following time standards:
 - a. Futures
 - b. Junior Nationals
 - c. Nationals/Olympic Trial Cut
- H. High School
 - a. Making League Finals
 - b. Making CIF
 - c. Making CIF Finals
 - d. Making State
 - e. Making State Finals
 - f. Being selected to All Valley Team or similar
 - g. Being Selected as a NISCA All-American
- I. Selection as USA Swimming Academic All- American (time standard and academics)
- J. Senior newsletter with bios on each graduating Senior
