

Wyoming Swimming Travel Policy/Code of Conduct

As a member of the Wyoming Swimming Western Zone Team, I understand and will comply with the following:

1. I understand that the possession or use of alcohol, tobacco products, and/or controlled substances is prohibited.
2. I understand that established curfews must be adhered to at all times.
3. I understand that attendance is required at all team functions, including but not limited to: meetings, practices, exhibitions, press conferences, and competitions unless otherwise excused or instructed by the Head Coach or Head Chaperone in charge of the team.
4. I understand that uniform requirement established for the trip must be followed.
5. I will show proper respect, sportsmanship, and courtesy toward coaches, officials, administrators, teammates, competitors, chaperones, and the public.
6. I understand that I will only be allowed to travel and/or leave my assigned room with my chaperone or teammate(s), or an adult who has received prior approval from the Head Coach and/or chaperone in charge of the team.
7. I understand that parents and/or members of the opposite sex will not be allowed to enter my room at any time (with the exception of swimmers under age 10 who are required to stay with their parents).
8. I will behave in a manner that present a positive image of Wyoming Swimming and will strive to promote an atmosphere conducive to meeting the competitive performance objectives.
9. I understand that I will be fully responsible for incidentals, damages and/or thievery at the hotel. (Room service is not permitted)!
10. I understand that I must participate in all contracted meals, unless the Head Coach has granted prior permission and or chaperone in charge of the team.
11. I understand that additional guidelines may be established as need to ensure the safety and well-being of Team Wyoming, and subsequently must be adhered to, as well.
12. Failure to comply with the Wyoming Swimming Swimmer Travel/Policy/Code of Conduct as set forth in this document and/or the USA Swimming Code of Conduct (Article 304) may result in disciplinary action, which may include but is not limited to the following:
 - a. Disqualification from one or more events of the competition.
 - b. Dismissal from the team with a timely scheduled return home, at my own expense.

- c. Disqualification from future Wyoming Swimming sponsored activities at the recommendation of the Head Coach.
