- The Aquatic Center at Mylan Park is configured as an 8 lane, 25-yard, short course competition pool.
- Water depth at start is 7'5" (minimum 5 feet required) and at turn end is 7'4".
- Colorado electronic timing system and scoreboard will be used.
- The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4).
- An adjacent 11 lane, 25-yard pool is available for continuous warm-up and warm-down throughout the competition.
- Spectator seating is available and restricted to the balcony area.
- Guest Wi-Fi is available.
- Swimmers will be seated on the pool deck. Bleachers (approximately 200 seats) are available plus there is sufficient deck space for swimmers to bring chairs.

ELIGIBILITY

ATHLETE

YMCA Membership: An athlete must be a YMCA member in good standing who holds an annual, full privilege membership at the YMCA he/she represents for a period of at least 30 days prior to the first day of the meet.

Swimmers who wish to change their membership from one YMCA to another may do so through Transfer by Consent. An athlete may transfer from one YMCA team to another YMCA team and be eligible to compete for his/her new YMCA team immediately upon the written consent of the YMCA that he/she previously represented.

For further detail, reference: SWIMMING ADDENDUM TO THE RULES THAT GOVERN YMCA COMPETITIVE SPORTS

Amateur Status: An athlete may not have represented a college, university or other post-high school institution in any competition and may not have accepted pay or compensation for competing as a swimmer.

Unattached Athletes: There is no unattached status in YMCA Swimming.

Age: An athlete must not older than twenty-one (21) years of age on the first day meet.

YMCA Meet Participation: In order to be eligible to compete, each athlete must have competed in a minimum of two (2) closed YMCA inter-association meets since September 1st, 2021.

Times: An athlete must achieve the minimum qualifying time standard for each event in which he/she enters during the period of September 1, 2020 and the entry deadline.

Athletes with a Disability: Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or team entry person must alert the meet director and the meet referee as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary, then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability prior to competition.

COACH

Teams without A Coach at the Meet: All athletes and teams must have at least one certified and credentialed YMCA coach designated as being responsible for their supervision during competition. When a YMCA team will not have a coach present, that YMCA may authorize an eligible coach from another YMCA attending the meet to be responsible for their athletes at the meet. The Meet Director and Meet Referee must be notified of this situation.

TEAM

Team Registration: Each team must have completed the annual YMCA on-line team registration and paid the annual registration fee prior to the entry deadline.

Insurance: Each team that participates in the meet must have a current and correct Certificate of Liability Insurance, in effect through the last day of the meet.

ENTRY INFORMATION

ENTRY LIMITS: Maximum of four (4) individual events.

QUALIFICATION PERIOD: The qualification period is September 1, 2020 through the entry deadline.

TIME STANDARDS: Swimmers must have equaled or bettered the minimum time standards for each event entered as listed in Appendix 2 of this document.

BONUS EVENTS: A swimmer who qualifies for one (1) or three (3) events in this meet may enter in one additional "Bonus" event; A swimmer who qualifies for two (2) events in this meet may enter in two additional "Bonus" events; not exceeding a total of four (4) events. The bonus event is the swimmers' choice and they do not need to meet the Silver (minimum) Qualifying standard, however they may not exceed the District (maximum) Qualifying time.

TIMES: No time entries (NT) are not allowed. Submit entry times in SCY. Entered times must be the swimmer's BEST time achieved during the qualifying period.

ENTRY FEES: \$6 per individual event + \$5 facility surcharge per swimmer

ENTRY DEADLINE: **THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2022 by 12 Noon**

***Supplemental entries will be accepted until 11:59 PM – Sunday, February 27, 2022
for any 10 & under swimmers who achieve the Silver qualifying standard at Novice Champs.**

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Entries shall be submitted using Hy-Tek or Team Unify Software. Team entry files should be emailed to: 22silverchamps@gmail.com

PAYMENT: Please bring your team check payable to "Uniontown YMCA Swim Team" to the Coach check-in table at Mylan Park.

VOLUNTEERS/OFFICIALS/TIMERS

OFFICIALS AND TIMERS: Each team entering swimmers will provide at least one timer and one official for each session that your team has swimmers entered. Additional volunteers are welcomed and encouraged. Meet volunteers are encouraged to sign up prior to the entry deadline.

SIGN-UP PROCEDURE: A Sign-Up Genius link will be sent to teams no later than February 26, 2022

ATHLETE PROTECTION (MAAPP) POLICY: All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Protection Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

MEET CHECK-IN PROCEDURE: All coaches, officials, timers and meet staff must sign in at the registration table located on the ground floor at the first entrance into the pool by the front desk.

COACHES MEETING: A coaches meeting will be held on deck at the beginning of each session for the purpose of communicating any changes to meet operations. Attendance by at least one coach from each team is mandatory.

OFFICIALS AND TIMERS MEETING: There will be an officials meeting followed by a timers meeting held on deck prior to the start of each session as outlined in the meet timeline.

CHAMPIONSHIP PROCEDURES AND OPERATIONS

CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE: The Committee will consist of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, and Administrative Referee. The Championship Committee will have the final authority on all procedural matters at the Championship.

RULES: The meet will run under Rules That Govern YMCA Competitive Sports, Swimming Addendum to the Rules That Govern YMCA Competitive Sports, and USA-S Technical Rules.

MEET FORMAT: The meet will be swum using a Timed finals format. Swimmer's age will be determined as of December 1, 2021.

EVENT SEEDING: All events will be seeded slowest to fastest, except for the 1000 & 1650 freestyle events which will be seeded fast to slow. The Meet Referee/Administrative Official reserve the right to combine heats and events after entries are received and/or after scratches are reported.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES: Coaches should turn in all scratches to the Administrative Official area utilizing the event report by session located in their coaches packets. This includes scratching an athlete entirely from the meet and also individual event scratches. There will not be a formal meeting to declare scratches at this meet.

DECLARED FALSE START: An athlete may also withdraw from a heat by electing to take a declared false start. Such declaration must be made known to the Deck Referee before the heat is announced. A declared false start counts as an event swum for the athlete and will be counted in the maximum number of events allowed for each athlete.

WARM-UP SAFETY PROCEDURES: Teams will be assigned lanes for warm-ups. No team has exclusive rights to any pool lanes during warm up period, during or before the start of the meet. Teams will need to share lane space and work cooperatively in reflection of the YMCA values and sportsmanship.

During designated warm up sessions, athletes may only enter the competition pools from the starting end. Athletes are expected to use a three-point entry in which they sit on the side of the pool then slide into the pool gently, with one hand on the wall. The exception is during specific warm up periods when sprint lanes are designated for practicing racing starts.

Coaches are responsible for the safety of their athletes and are expected to monitor them at all times during warm up sessions.

STARTS: 'Fly-over' starts will be used at this meet. All swimmers (except for backstroke starts) should remain in the water at the completion of their race until the next heat has begun.

RESULTS: Any results displayed on the scoreboard are unofficial until final results are published. Results will be posted near the concession area.

PROTEST PROCEDURE: Protests may only be initiated by a person with standing, that is, a coach or YMCA supervisor whose team is competing in the meet. The Championship committee will arbitrate protests, eligibility issues, safety rules and other issues.

Protests against the judgment decisions of starters, stroke, turn, place and relay take-off judges can only be considered by the Referee and the Referee's decisions will be final (USA-S Rule 102.23).

CONDUCT AND RESTRICTIONS: The Meet Referee reserves the right to dismiss any swimmer, coach and/or spectator from the competition due to inappropriate conduct

- Deck access is limited to only registered and approved coaches, swimmers, officials, session timers, and working meet staff.
- Except where the venue facilities require otherwise, changing, into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. The USA Swimming Rulebook defines Deck Change as: "Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit (excluding a drag suit) in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes while at a practice, competition, or other pool-related activity." This includes slipping off the top of a one-piece performance suit to place on an alternate bikini top immediately following a race.
- Glass and Food are not permitted on deck.
- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Photographs are not allowed to be taken behind the block anytime swimmers are present.
- Massage tables are not permitted.
- Individuals are responsible for the security of their personal belongings and are encouraged not to bring valuables to the meet venue and not to leave items unattended.
- Swimmers are not permitted in the spectator stands.
- Shaving is not permitted in any areas of the facility.
- The Diving Well and Recreational Pool areas of the facility will be in use during the competition and are not available for use by participants of the meet.

TECHNICAL SUIT RESTRICTIONS: USA Swimming rule 102.8.1.F will be enforced. No FINA approved suit may be worn by any 12 & under athlete participating in this competition unless the suit bears an additional manufacturer's green check mark next to the FINA logo on the suit or the suit has been pre-approved by the Meet/Deck Referee prior to the start of the session.

AWARDS AND RECOGNITION

SCORING: This meet will not be scored.

AWARDS: Swimmers who achieve a District Qualifying Time will receive a commemorative District Qualifier award. A swimmer may advance to their respective District Championship if they achieve a qualifying time at this meet.

Medals will be awarded to the swimmers who finish in the top Three (3) with non-District Qualifying times, in each event. Ribbons will be awarded for places 4 – 12 with non-District Qualifying times, in each event.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, awards ceremonies will not take place throughout the meet. Coaches will receive their team's awards at the conclusion of each session.

TIME TRIALS

Time Trials will be held as requested if time allows. The Meet director will have the final decision on the number of entries to be accepted.

SPECTATORS

ADMISSION FEE: \$5 per spectator, ages 12 and under admitted free.

HEAT SHEETS/PROGRAMS: Heat Sheets will be available on site for \$5.

CONCESSION STAND: Concessions will be offered through the Mylan Park vendor.

APPAREL: Meet apparel will be available for pre-order through Swimmer's Network. Further information to follow.

HANDICAP SEATING: Handicapped seating with elevator access is available.

CONDUCT AND RESTRICTIONS:

- No Flash Photography at the start of competition races.
- No personal chairs are allowed in the spectator area
- Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children. Children are not allowed to roam the facility unattended.
- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Spectators are not permitted on deck
- No smoking, drugs, or alcohol are permitted in the swimming complex.

LIABILITY, SAFETY AND EMERGENCY PROCEDURE

INSURANCE: Each Association participating in this meet must have insurance coverage for representative(s) including leadership and participants who will be in attendance for the period of the meet.

LIABILITY LIMITS: By awarding this Championship to the host team, it is understood and agreed the Western PA YMCA Swim League shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the meet.

EMERGENCIES: The facility personnel will handle all emergencies at the meet. These individuals will provide CPR and first aid as needed and will ensure that individuals with serious injuries are transported immediately to the nearest hospital for further treatment.

Any coach, athlete or official who recognizes an emergency situation should immediately inform the facility's personnel and then make sure the vicinity of the emergency is clear for the emergency personnel to do their job.

CONCUSSION AWARENESS: This meet will follow the YMCA of USA Concussion procedure. Anyone who observes or has knowledge of a potential head injury should immediately notify lifeguards and/or hired medical personnel. Once the injury report is completed, the lifeguard and/or hired medical personnel will notify the Event Staff, the athlete's coaching staff, and the Meet Director.

If a head injury occurs, the action plan below will be followed:

1. Athlete is removed immediately from participation by the Meet Director
2. Athlete must be evaluated by a licensed health care professional experienced in identifying and treating concussions. In addition, the athlete must be in compliance with the laws that are in effect within the jurisdiction where the meet is held.
3. The coaching staff will inform the athlete's parents or guardians about the possible concussion and give or send them the fact sheet on concussion.
4. The athlete will not be allowed back to warm-up or compete until a health care professional, experienced in evaluating concussions determines that the athlete is symptom-free and is OK to return to participation.

LIGHTNING POLICY: The National Lightning Safety Institute, National Athletic Trainers Association, American College of Emergency Physicians, USA Swimming, and YMCA of the USA all recommend or require closing an indoor pool during an electrical storm. This policy will be followed at the meet.

DRONES: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

COVID-19

We have taken enhanced health and safety measures for athletes, coaches, officials, spectators, and others participating in this meet. You must follow all safety instructions while visiting and/or participating in this competition. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By entering this venue, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

YMCA Swimming and USA Swimming, Inc., cannot prevent you (or your child(ren)) from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while participating in this YMCA event. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease.
