- To Offer a High Quality Meet while maintaining safety protocols
- To Motivate swimmers by giving them something to look forward to at the end of this season

COVID Safety:

- We expect everyone to self-monitor for symptoms, and we ask you not attend the meet if you show symptoms of COVID, or have knowingly been exposed to someone who has tested positive.
- Temperature Checks will be taken for all swimmers, coaches, and volunteers.
- Everyone will wear a mask while in the building, except for swimmers while they swim or prepare to swim.
- Social Distancing will be required in all areas and will be monitored.
- Breaks between sessions will allow for cleaning, and reduce interaction between swimmers in different sessions.
- The meet format has been adjusted to encourage COVID safety, including a limited number of swimmers per session;
- Most swimmers will only swim one day, reducing travel related risk of hotels and meals.

- Spectators will not be permitted. The meet will be streamed Live, and Results will be on Meet Mobile.
- A Minimum number of meet workers will be allowed in the building.
- We will limit the number of coaches on deck.
- We will not have vendors or a concession stand to help reduce the spread of the virus.
- Shirts and apparel will be available online.

Spectators:

We regret that spectators will not be allowed to attend the meet. This is the only option in order to allow enough swimmers in the meet. Look for Live Streaming and Live Results online and on Meet Mobile.

Qualifying Times:

- In 2021 there will be 'A' (Automatic) and 'B' (Consideration) Qualifying Standards. Swimmers entering with the A Qualifying Standards will automatically be entered in the meet. Swimmers with B Qualifying Standards will be considered for the meet and will be based on a limited number of swimmers per session.
- A final psych sheet will be posted at least 8 days before the first day of the meet so swimmers, coaches, and families can plan for the meet.
- 1 Bonus Event is available for swimmers who have one individual event, or one relay event.
- The qualifying period has been extended back to January 1, 2019.
- Eligibility requirements have been extended back to September 1, 2019.

Entry Information:

Entries are due, Tuesday, March 9, 2021 at 8:00 PM.

Entry Limits.

- Friday swimmers can enter / swim up to 3 Individual Events.
- All Saturday and Sunday Sessions, Maximum entries are 5 per session, with no more than 4 Ind. Entries. (Sat & Sun Max Entries 4 Ind & 1 Relay or 3 Ind & 2 Relays.)
