- Expanded the Southwest Ohio District Swim League from seven teams to twenty teams with approximately 2000 competitors.
- Introduced the national order of events into League championships.
- Served on the Great Lakes Region Competitive Swim Committee for over ten years and as its chairman.
- Active in promulgating the National YMCA Officials Certification program on the League and Regional levels.
- Served as Records Chairman of the National Competitive Swimming and Diving Committee.
- Serves as Secretary of the YMCA of the USA Swimming and Diving Committee.
- Serves as Meet Director of the YMCA of the USA Swimming and Diving Long Course Championships.
- Recipient of the Conrad Carroll Award in 1986.

His contributions to the National YMCA Swimming and Diving program have been extremely important. Under his tutelage, the Long Course program has grown and has had great success. His contact with competitors and adults alike has had a very positive effect.
