- Serves as National YMCA Swimming and Diving Officials Chairman.
- Recipient of the National YMCA Conrad Carroll Award presented for outstanding dedication to the YMCA Swimming and Diving Officials Program.

Bill, currently the Executive Director of the Glenwood Park YMCA, Erie, Pa. has been honored as a Directorate of Physical Education. He recently was elected to the Pennsylvania Swimming Hall of Fame.
